

# A Season of Style

COORDINATING BACK TO BACK KITS,  
PERFECT FOR CHRISTMAS GIVING

## DIRECTIONS WRITTEN TO CREATE ONE OF EACH CARD

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### CARD 1

1. Stamp the backside of one ornament die-cut card circle with sentiment.
2. Sponge over one of the large plain die-cut circles completely with Cherry Cobbler ink to border the sentiment circle.
3. Cut (or punch) a 1-1/2" circle out of one of the white die-cut flag tags. Sponge completely with Cherry Cobbler ink to border the snowflake circle.
4. Cut (or punch) one of the snowflake flag tags into a 1-1/4" circle, centering the snowflake.
5. Trim one of the green plaid card bases to create a 1-3/4" X 4-1/4" strip (the white backside is used to create the white strip behind the circles and leaves).
6. Score one of the metallic gold banners lengthwise twice to create a striped pattern. Cut in half to create two 1/2" x 1-1/8" pieces.
7. Using the outside border edges of the Cherry Cobbler die-cut flag sheets, cut a 3/8" x 4-1/4" strip, a 3/8" x 1" strip, and a 3/8" x 1-1/4" strip. These are used as the left and right borders along the white card strip.
8. Finish cards as shown. Note that the snowflake circle is mounted to the front of the card using the extra from the foam circles.

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### CARD 2

1. Trim three of the Cherry Cobbler die-cut flags to 2-3/8" in length.
2. Cut three of the snowflake flags to create 1-1/4" squares.
3. Cut three 1-1/2" squares out of the white flag tags.
4. Cut a 1-3/4" x 5-1/2" green plaid strip and a 3-3/4" x 5" card (to be used on the inside of the card) out of one of the green plaid card bases. Optional: Stamp the bottom right corner of the 3-3/4" x 5" card with three snowflakes in Cherry Cobbler ink.
5. Reverse fold one of the green plaid card bases. This creates the white card base used in this design.
6. Stamp the bottom right corner of the white card base with sentiment.
7. Cut (or punch) three 3/8" circles out of one of the gold foil banners.
8. Using the leftover borders around the gold foil banners create two thin strips to be used as the right border along the plaid strip.
9. Finish cards as shown. Note that the snowflake squares are mounted using the extra from the foam circles.

## SHAKER BOX



Shaker Box

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1. Trim 5/8" from the left edge and 1-1/4" from the top edge of the ornament cards to create two 3-1/8" W x 3-3/4" card pieces.
2. Trim two of the 3-3/4" x 5" plain die-cut circle cards to 3-3/4" x 4-1/2" by cutting 1/2" off the 5" length, centering the circle. Score the 3-3/4" sides of both cards at 3/8" and fold back.
3. Glue the die-cut circle cards together along the 3/8" score lines alternating the ornament cards and plain cards to create one long strip. Do not attach the last edges to the box shape until you have completed decorating the shaker boxes.
4. Stamp the shaker box back cards with sentiments of choice. Randomly glue several of each sequin to the card so they appear to be floating when the box is upright. Finish the shaker box cards adding additional free floating sequins within each circle.
5. Glue the last edges of the die-cut circle cards together to form a box shape.
6. Cut one of the green plaid card bases to create two 4" by 4-5/8" cards. Score all sides of both cards at 3/8" and fold towards the inside. Cut each right corner of the cards along the score line up to the next score line. Attach the small flaps created to the inside edge of the sides to create a lid and bottom to your box. Glue the bottom of the box to the box sides.
7. To create the bow, cut four 1" x 8-1/2" and one 1" x 4-1/4" strips out of a green plaid card base. Using a bone folder, curl the strips from the underside until the paper separates. Pull the two pieces apart, keeping only the patterned side for your bow. Glue the 1" edges of each 8-1/2" strip to the center fold line, creating a loop. Layer the loops on top of each other rotating each loop to form an "x". Glue the 4-1/4" strip together to form a ring. Glue in center of bow. Attach bow to the box lid.
8. Finish box as shown adding a fun tag.

## BONUS PROJECT – Silverware holder

1. Cut two 1-3/4" x 8-1/2" strips out of a green plaid card base. Score along the 1" side every 1/4"; fanfold. Glue the two strips together along the 1" sides creating a circle. Holding each fanfold together one at a time, trim the edges into a "V" shape. I used the plaid square pattern as a guide cutting from one square to the next at an angle.
2. Stamp one of the ornament circles with small snowflake images in Dapper Denim ink. Attach to the center of the fanfold circle.
3. Create tag as shown and clip to the ornament circle.
4. Attach the fanfold circle to the front of the stocking. Add a napkin and silverware and you're ready for the party to begin!
