

Birthday Bonanza Three Tier Slider Card

You will need:

1. Bermuda Bay 12" x 12" cardstock
 - One 3" x 3"
 - One 3-1/8" x 10-1/4"
 - One 4-1/2" x 11-5/8"
 - One 3" x 4"
2. Pool Party cardstock
 - One 2-1/4" x 2-7/8"
 - One 2-1/2 x 3-1/4"
3. Whisper White cardstock
 - One 2-3/16" x 3-3/8"
 - One 3-1/2" x 4-1/8"
4. Daffodil Delight cardstock
 - 1" x 4"
 - 1-1/2" Circle
5. Calypso Coral cardstock
 - 1" x 4"
6. Any DSP
 - (2) 1/2" x 3-1/4"

Directions:

1. Score the 4-1/2" x 11-5/8" cardstock piece along the 11-5/8" edge at 3-7/8"; burnish. Fold the opposite end to the fold line; burnish. Align the right fold line along the left 1" mark on your trimmer and cut a slit from 1/2" to 3". Move the edge of the cardstock piece to the right 1" mark on your cutter and cut another slit from 1/2" x 3". Fold the right panel of the card to the left fold. Slide one of the 1/2" x 3-1/4" strips beneath the two slits as shown. Fold the ends of the strips towards each other and score. You do not want this too tight and it needs to slide up and down easily. Too loose and your mechanism will wobble. Just like Goldilocks, you need to get this just right.



2. Score the 3-1/8" x 10-1/4" cardstock piece along the 10-1/4" edge at 3-3/8"; burnish. Align the right fold line along the left 1" mark on your trimmer and cut a slit from 1/4" to 2-1/2". Move the edge of the cardstock piece to the right 1" mark on your cutter and cut another slit from 1/4" x 2-1/2". Fold the right panel of the card to the left fold. Slide one of the 1/2" x 3-1/4" strips beneath the two slits as shown. Fold the ends of the strips towards each other and score. You may need to trim the ends as you do not want the ends to overlap. Once again, you do not want this to be too tight.



3. Open the cards and add Tear and Tape along the inside left edges and the 1/2" strips on both cards.
4. On the 3-1/8" x 10-1/4" piece remove the Tear and Tape from the small strip and adhere the top of the 3" x 3" cardstock piece to the top, center of the card. The bottom of the 3" x 3" piece will attach to the 1/2" strip. Close the right side of the card to the left fold line. Remove the Tear and tape on the left side and close the card which will incase the 3" x 3" card. Fold the 1-1/2" punched circle in half and glue it to the top of the 3" x 3" card. The fold line should be approximately 1/4" above the top of the card. This will indicate that the piece should be pulled upwards to the recipient.
5. Attach the back side (with the seam line) of 3-1/2" card created in Step 4 to the 4-1/2" x 11-5/8" card on the right panel, aligning the tops just like you did for the 3" x 3" in Step 4. Close the right side of the card to the left fold line. Remove the Tear and Tape on the left side and close the card to incase the 3-1/2" card. Your mechanism should now slide up and down easily.
6. Stamp and decorate your card pieces as desired. Note: All of the pieces should be completely glued around the edges and be as flat as possible so they do not catch on in the pockets as you slide the pieces up and down. The bottom edges of the decorated cards slide under the top edges of the pockets. You will need the following pieces of cardstock to re-create the card as shown.
 - a. 2" x 2-3/4", 2-1/4" x 3-1/8", and 2-13/16" x 3-3/8" Whisper White
 - b. 2-1/4" x 2-7/8", 2-1/2" x 3-1/4", and 3-3/4" x 4-1/4" Bermuda Bay
 - c. 3-5/8" x 4-1/8" Designer Series Paper
7. Glue a 3-1/2" x 4-1/8" piece of Whisper White cardstock to the back of the card and if desired, decorate it and your envelope with coordinating stamps and inks.
8. Stamp the back, top card section with "Stamped by" image; sign.

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
