
Adhesives: Stampin' Seal, Stampin' Dimensionals, Multipurpose Liquid Glue

Tools: Paper Trimmer, Scissors, Bone Folder, Take Your Pick Tool (poker), Stampin' Cut & Emboss and accessories, Stylish Shapes and Rectangle Stitched Framelits Dies*, 3/8"*, 2-1/8"*, and 2-3/8" Circle Punches (punches in lieu of dies) **OPTIONAL - Stampin' Blends (light and dark of each color):**

Darling Duckling (yellow), Timid Tiger (peachyorange), Old Olive (green)

CARD 1 CUTTING GUIDE:

- Kit Card Base: Fold card in half at scoreline, trim through both layers to create a closed card base that is 4" x 5-1/4". Score top flap vertically at 2".
- CS "A" Back Matte: 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"
- CS "A" Matte: 3-5/8" x 4-7/8"
- Scenic DSP: 3-3/8" x 4-5/8", 3-7/8" x 5-1/8", 1-7/8" x 5-1/8" (x2)

CARD 2 CUTTING GUIDE:

- Kit Card Base: Fold card in half at scoreline, trim through both layers to create a closed card base that is 4" x 5-1/4".
- CS "A" Back Matte Layer: 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"
- CS "A" DSP Matte Layers: 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" (x3)
- CS "A" Circle: 2-3/8"
- CS "B" Circle: 2-1/8" (x2)**
- Envelope DSP Layers: 1-1/4" x 3-1/4" (one of each of the three colors)**





**Cut with Paper Trimmer, punch or dies.

CARD 3 GIFT CARD HOLDER CUTTING GUIDE:

- Kit Card Base: Fold card in half at scoreline, trim through both layers to create a closed card base that is 4" x 5-1/4". Cut a 2" vertical strip from the right edge of the top flap.
- CS "A" Back Matte Layer: 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"
- CS "A" Matte: 2-3/4" x 3-3/4"



Don't throw your envelopes away. I will show you during the video how to fix them so they don't go to waste. You will need coordinating DSP.
